# 2023 Sehring Medal of Excellence for Healthcare Honoree **Daniel Reyes Co, M.D.**



Dr. Dan Co is a hometown hero. Born and raised in Lockport, he followed in his father's footsteps opening a private practice in the town where everyone knows his name. Over the past three decades, Dr. Co has cared for generations of families while serving as a respected leader at Silver Cross Hospital – most recently serving as Chief of Staff helping guide us through the Covid-19 pandemic.

He was destined to become a physician. His dad, Dr. Bun Siu Co, is an internal medicine and nephrology physician who received the Silver Cross Sehring Medical of Excellence in 2004 for his own outstanding service to the healthcare profession. All his parents' friends are physicians. Even his wife, Dr. Kit Lee, is a family practitioner. They met while studying pre-med at Northwestern University. Board-certified in internal medicine, Dr. Co earned his medical degree at the University of Illinois - Rockford and completed both his internship and residency at Rush Presbyterian - St. Luke's Medical Center before joining Kit as a traveling hospitalist. After three years, they returned home, and Dr. Co joined the Silver Cross Medical Staff in 1999.

Over time, Dr. Co became more involved serving in several leadership positions including Chair of the Department of Medicine, Treasurer, and Chair-Elect before being appointed Chief of Staff in 2021. Not only did he help lead Silver Cross out of the pandemic, but it was during Dr. Co's tenure that Silver Cross earned the Triple Crown for Healthcare – 100 Top Hospital status, 5-star Rating by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid, and an A for Patient Safety from the Leapfrog Group - all at the same time.

In addition to advancing quality, safety and service at Silver Cross, Dr. Co was instrumental in assisting the Silver Cross Foundation raise over \$2 million to advance heart care by creating an open heart and structural heart surgical program which is now one of the busiest heart programs in the State of Illinois. He is also a champion for physician wellness at Silver Cross.

Today, Dr. Co resides in Frankfort, and together with Kit, has three adult children, Dana, Nathan and Elizabeth.

Because of Dan's commitment to improving the quality of life in our region, the Silver Cross Board of Directors proudly awards him with the 2023 Silver Cross Sehring Medal of Excellence for Healthcare.

### 2023 Sangmeister Medal of Excellence for Community Service Honoree **Timothy A. Baldermann**



A devoted and servant leader, Tim Baldermann is serving his fifth term as mayor of New Lenox, donating his annual salary to aid members of his community that need financial help with medical bills, housing or educational assistance for their children. Under his guidance, New Lenox has received the Governor's Hometown Award, Safe Community designation from the World Health Organization and National Safety Council, Best Municipality, One of the Best Places to Live, and Best Festivals

for Christmas in the Commons. He was also instrumental in bringing the Silver Cross replacement hospital and Silver Oaks Behavioral Hospital to New Lenox and surrounding communities.

In addition to serving as mayor, Tim is superintendent of the Union School District 81 in Joliet and former Police Chief of Chicago Ridge, retiring in 2010. He earned a bachelor's degree from Governor's State University and began his career in law enforcement, graduating from the Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Academy in Quantico, Virginia, before joining the Chicago Ridge Police Department where he served 9 of those years as Chief of Police. Tim has earned awards for domestic violence prevention and efforts to combat narcotics trafficking, twice receiving the International Association of Narcotics Enforcement Award. He has also received the Sheriff's Medal of Honor.

Before being elected Mayor in 2007, Tim served on the New Lenox Board of Trustees. He also served as President of the New Lenox District 122 School Board for four years, Chairman of the Board of Directors for Laraway Communication Center and Director on the Metra Board. He received the "Those Who Excel Award" from the State Board of Education and in 2022's Southland's Best was voted Best Mayor. Earlier this year, he saved a women's life while vacationing in New York City, performing CPR until paramedics arrived.

Tim and his wife, Megan, an elementary school principal, have five children and seven grandchildren.

Because of Tim's commitment to improving the quality of life in our region, the Silver Cross Board of Directors proudly awards him with the 2023 Silver Cross Sangmeister Medal of Excellence for Community Service.



**Rev. Kay Collins** 

(1942 - 2023)

Rev. Kay Collins joined Silver Cross Hospital as the Chaplin in 1974. She continued as Chaplain for 40 years and retired in 2014.
